Executive Director Paul Seguin said scholarship applications are reviewed and awarded throughout the year based upon availability of funds. One-year scholarships are awarded to students 16-25 years of age who meet and maintain the required academic standards each term. Scholarships can cover not only tuition, but also others costs associated with attending school.
