The first thing the attorney will want to do is review all of the facts surrounding your case. You should bring as much information to the initial consultation as possible. This includes the following:

- The date, time, and location of your accident
- The names and contact information of any witnesses
- Copies of any accident reports
- Copies of your medical records and doctor bills
- Documentation of any lost income

You do not need to have all of this information when you meet with an attorney, but the more information you have, the better we can assess your case.

Assessing the Strengths and Weaknesses of Your Claim

Once we have reviewed the facts of your claim, we can determine whether you have a claim for compensation. This involves identifying the cause of your accident, how you might prove the other party was negligent, and what evidence you have and may need to prove your claim.
